

Conference: Travel information

Travel by air: Manchester Airport is about 10 miles (16km) south of the city centre, about 30 minutes from the university.

The airport has a number of transport links to the city:

Train - The airport's two terminals are linked directly to the city centre by a fast, frequent 24 hour train link to central Manchester, to both Piccadilly and Oxford Road stations.

Taxi - A taxi from the airport will cost approximately £15.

Bus - Local buses also run to the Oxford Road campus.

Travel by train: There are three main train stations in Manchester: Piccadilly, Oxford Road and Victoria. From Piccadilly station catch the Oxford Road Link bus (no 147) or take a taxi (about £5). From Oxford Road station it is a 10-15 minute walk. Alternatively, buses stop outside the Palace Hotel. From Victoria station take buses 191 or 197 (from Corporation Street, outside the Co-operative Bank) or get a taxi (about £6)

Travel by car: All approach routes are clearly signposted 'The University of Manchester'. If you need more detailed information, see <http://www.manchester.ac.uk/visitors/travel/directions/>

Parking: Car parking is available at the University. Both the Manchester Aquatics Centre multi-storey car park on Booth Street East (Campus map: Car Park B) and the multi-storey on Booth Street West (Campus map: Car Park D) offer paid public parking and are convenient and safe.
